

# STERLING PARK DISTRICT GARTNER PARK

DESCRIPTION: Gartner Park is a 34 acre park dedicated to baseball. The park includes two t-ball diamonds, four Little League diamonds and two senior league diamonds.

Sterling Park District hired Wendler to develop a master plan for the park so that they could better serve the community. The first project completed was the design and reconstruction of the senior league diamond which is also the home of the Sterling High School baseball team. Improvements included complete reconstruction of the diamond with new fencing, an underdrain system, lighting and concession stand.

The next phase of improvements centered on providing handicap accessibility to two of the Little League diamonds. In order to achieve this goal, a hard surface was needed from the parking lot to the baseball diamonds. The existing sealcoat and grass parking lot was widened and improved with curb & gutter and asphalt pavement. Concrete pavement was constructed from the parking lot to the seating areas and the dugouts. Limestone aggregate was added from the dugouts to the bullpens.
