Project Description

LOCATION: Sterling, Illinois

PROJECT COST: \$725,000

COMPLETED: On-Going

DESCRIPTION: Wendler was commissioned to perform engineering services to investigate the feasibility of providing a 10 foot wide separated bicycle trail with parking from Sinissippi Park to the Dillon Home, a distance of approximately 1.5 miles.

This work included studying various alignment corridors to identify a preferred trail alignment. Services included preparing construction plans and cost estimates.

The scope of work included general topographic survey and contour mapping at one foot intervals; preservation and protection of natural areas; identifying alignment options that are in compliance with AASHTO and ADA guidelines; and identifying the type, size and locations for all drainage structures.

Every year the Sterling Park District continues to construct segments of the path. Many segments have been done through various state & federal grants.
